

***“Does your work zone
PASS the test?”***



- P**ATH – An **obvious, consistent, predictable, and well-maintained** path through the entire work zone for vehicles, bicyclists, and pedestrians
- A**TTENTION – Directs road user attention to the roadway and is free of distractions
- S**PEED – Designed to control and encourage vehicle speeds that allow for **safe and efficient** passage for all roadway users
- S**AFE OPERATIONS – Work operations are conducted safely, create safe site conditions for workers and roadway users, and permit **safe access into and out of work area by equipment**
