## From Portland (approximately 2 hours)

- 1. Take I-5 Southbound. Most of your travel time will be on I-5.
- 2. Drive past the exit for Albany. (Albany is approximately 20-30 min. south of Salem.)
- 3. Take Exit 228 (Highway 34). Turn right (west) at the end of the ramp.
- 4. Continue on Highway 34 about 10 miles. This turns into Harrison and will take you through downtown Corvallis.
- 5. Turn left (south) on 25th. This street becomes Park Terrace after you cross Monroe.
- 6. The Kelley Engineering Center is at the end of Park Terrace

## From the Eugene Airport (less than 1 hour)

- 1. Exit the Eugene Airport, heading south.
- 2. Turn left (east) onto Airport Road.
- 3. Turn left (north) at the intersection (and onto Highway 99).
- 4. At the north end of Junction City, the road splits in a Y. Turn left onto Highway 99W.
- 5. After about 40 min. you'll enter Corvallis.
- 6. Highway 99W eventually turns into 3rd Street. Get in the far left lane.
- 7. Turn left (west) on Harrison.
- 8. Turn left (south) on 25th. This street becomes Park Terrace after you cross Monroe.
- 9. The Kelley Engineering Center is at the end of Park Terrace.
