



Why Are These Notes Here?

The Scenario:

Joe Graphics submits his project PDF file to *teach* on time. He then realizes he didn't submit his source code, so he makes another *teach* submission with just the source code, adding it to the PDF he already submitted.

The moral of the story: if you need to add more files to your *teach* submission, re-submit *everything*.
