

- Some things that instructor could do to improve the course could be going over the assigned homework problems and making sure that he has taught enough material for the students to actually be able to the problems, because sometimes he had not taught everything we needed to know to do some of the problems. Or if there is something in the textbook that the students need to go over on their own, he should talk about that in class.
- It didn't bother me, but we often stayed a few minutes past the end of class and I know some students had another class directly after.
- slow down and actually just show equations and step by step how do use the equations, he always had to show us how to get to the equation and the stuff relating to the equation but not just writing out the equation

- Very accommodating. Is enthusiastic and makes the class fun.
- He is not good at just giving clear instructions, he often goes around the points and always goes over time. He is also unclear about deadlines, he is always moving them last minute and then take forever to grade them and give them back so it is very unclear what the accurate grade is. He also grades extremely harsh on exams, not giving partial credit in many instances which was never communicated and makes one bad test absolutely tank grades with it being very hard to recover
