- I wish there were some printable notes or vocab lists to refer to. The other great help would be to label the videos. When I have to go back and look some vocab word up, I have to sift through so many old videos to find the one I need. I wish each video had a list of the main ideas that it will talk about. I am sure Amy would have been great, but the new teacher has not graded anything for weeks. Not one discussion post all term has been graded since Amy left. He is also not grading quizzes on time or allowing us to re-do them. Having a teacher leave is detrimental to EOU classes. This has been a HUGE problem at EOU. This is my 4th teacher in a year to leave mid term. It makes it difficult each time.
- I would change the number of quizzes that are given. For an online course, this was a lot of work, and although I don't think these quizzes were too challenging I would present them with at least two attempts.
