3) The label on a bag of concrete says "60 pounds," but the true weight is only 58 pounds.

4) Your bike speedometer reads 26 miles per hour when you are actually traveling 24 miles per hour.

5) Your actual body temperature is 98.4°F, but your thermometer gives a reading of 97.9°F.
