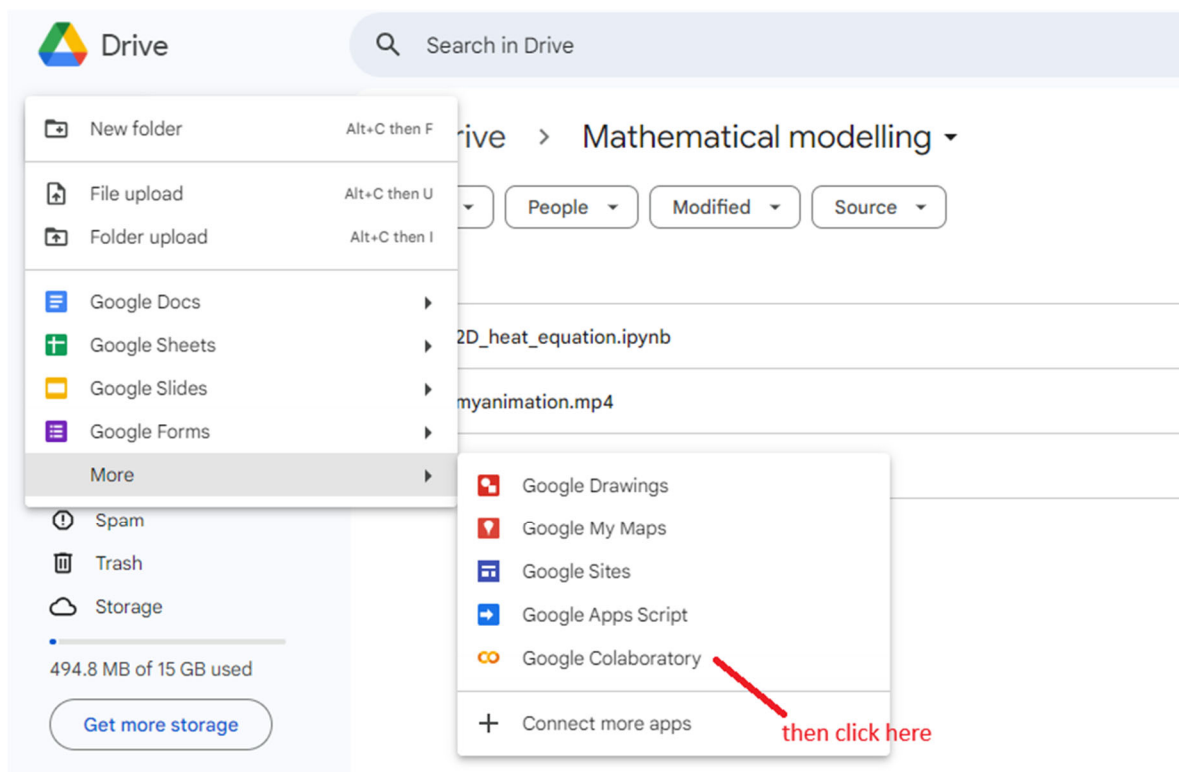
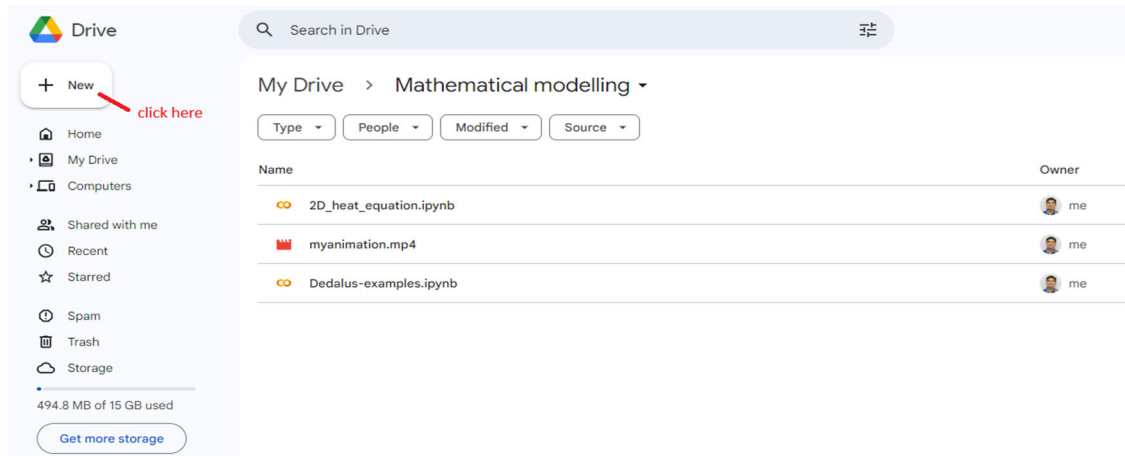


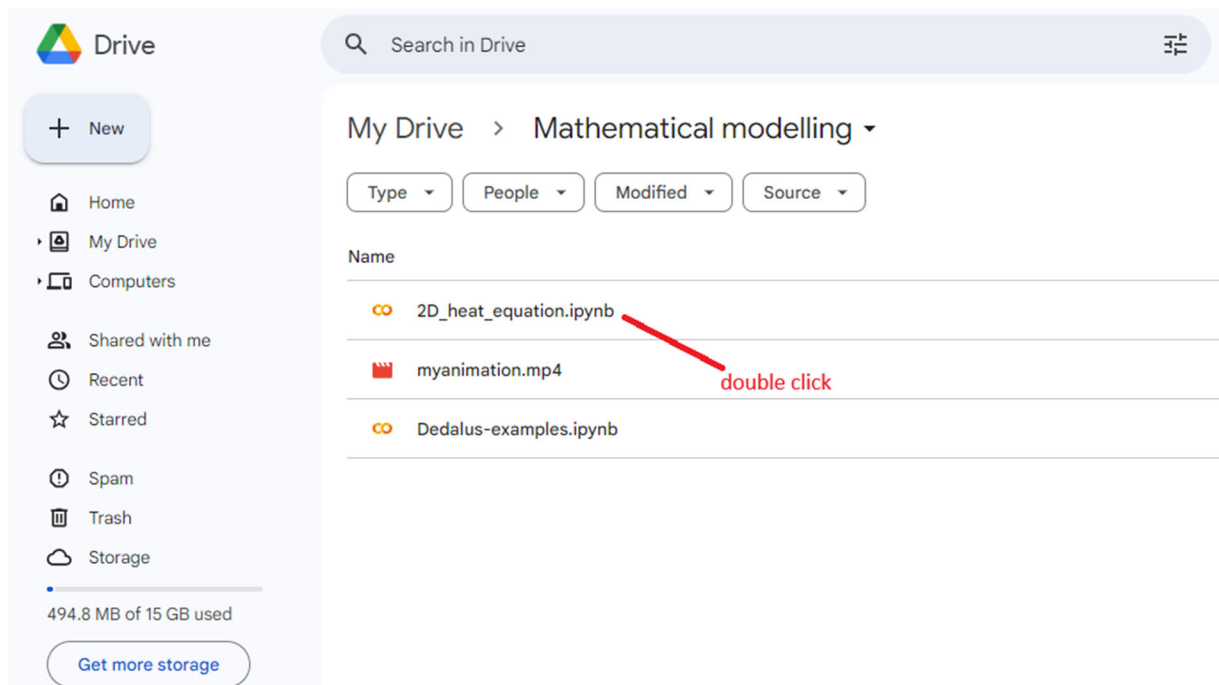
## Working with ipynb files on Google Colab

If you have an ipynb file stored on Google Drive, you can create/open/run/edit it as follows:

1. Go to Google Drive
2. If you want to create a blank ipynb file, click on the plus sign “New”. A menu will show up, from which you choose “More” and then choose “Google Colaboratory”. If you don’t see “Google Colaboratory” as an option, then click on “Connect more apps” and search for “Google Colaboratory” from the list to install. (Don’t worry, nothing is installed on your web-browser or computer. You are just “connecting” the Google Colaboratory app to your Google account.)



3. To open an existing ipynb file, just double click on that file.



You may see the screen below on the first time you open an ipynb file on Google Drive. Just click on either “Open with Google Colaboratory” on the top or “Google Colaboratory” at the bottom and it will take you to Google Colab.
